



China's ranking on the Global Innovation Index jumped from 29th in 2015 to **14th** in 2020




507 Chinese companies made it to the 2019 EU Industrial R&D Investment Scoreboard,

The number of advanced and new technology companies reached 225,000 in 2019, almost triple since 2015








By the end of 2019, urbanization rate for the permanent resident population rose to 60.6%, up 4.5 percentage points from 2015

Share of good air quality days




in 337 cities at or above the prefecture level in 2019


Retention rate of nine-year compulsory education: 94.8 %
